Volunteers are needed. Baked goods should be dropped off the morning of the sale.



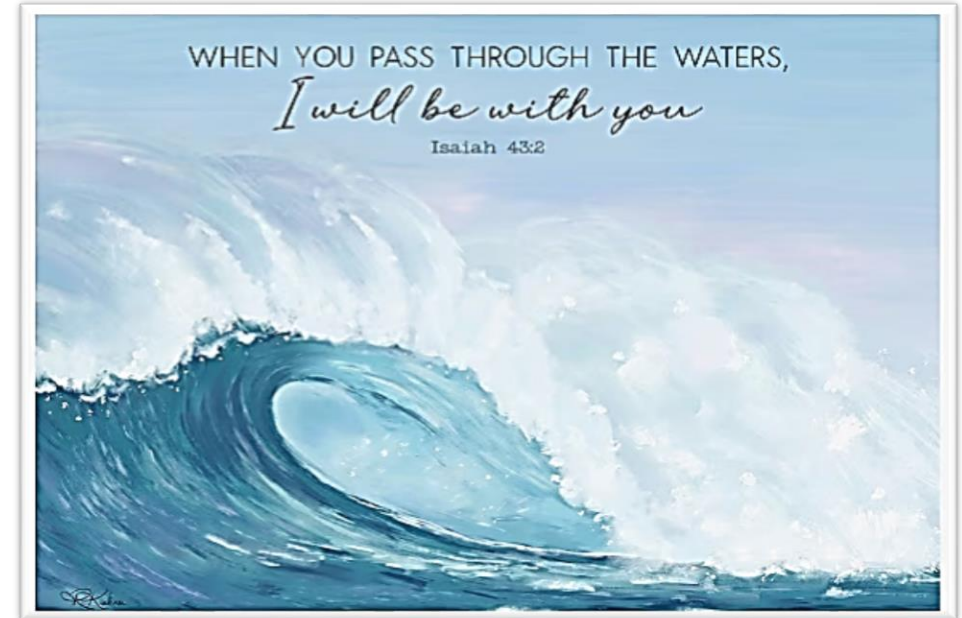
